Firearms

We recognize that there are a wide variety of reactions to the safety/danger of firearms within our community, with some members choosing to own and store firearms in their homes while others feel that their safety is compromised by the presence of these firearms.

In order to maximize the perception of safety for everyone while respecting legal rights, all firearms within PDX Commons must be:

- Legally obtained and in the possession of a PDXC resident.
- Registered with the HOA, if a permanently stored firearm. Such registration will include contact information about next of kin and/or durable power of attorney. (Recognizing that the risk of dementia increases with the aging process, we reserve the right to seek consultation with family or POA should a firearm owner's behavior become unstable or unpredictable).
- Securely stored within individual homes with ammunition stored separately (gun safes and locks strongly recommended).
- Cased, unloaded, and transported discreetly through the PDXC building when necessary to move the firearm between individual homes and the outside of the building.

All Common Spaces of PDXC (including guest rooms) are otherwise considered firearm-free zones.

The HOA may revise this policy as needed to maintain safe storage and handling of firearms and ensure a safe living environment for residents of PDX Commons.
